Western United FC 'Show Your Colours at AAMI Park Competition (the "Promotion") Terms & Conditions (the "Terms")

Information on how to enter the Promotion and how to win the Prizes forms part of these Terms. Participation in this Promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms.

1. Definitions.

In these Terms, unless the context indicates a contrary intention:

Winner/s means an entrant who is randomly selected via random selection program at AAMI Park on Sunday 6 November.

Eligible Match is the Western United vs. Adelaide United match on 6 November 2022 (kick off at 5PM) at AAMI Park, Melbourne.

Promotional Period has the meaning set out in clause 2.

2. Promotion Period

Promotion commences at 12:00pm AEST on 26 October 2022 and ends at 5.00 PM AEST on 6 November 2022 nationwide across Australia ("Promotional Period").

3. Eligible Entrants

- (a) Entry is only open to all VIC residents aged under 18 years old who are available to attend the Event (defined above) and have tickets to the Event. Nomination is to be from a parent, guardian contact details with the nominated eligible entrant specified on the entry form.
- (b) Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter and agencies associated with this Promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.

- (c) Be an eligible person of entry as defined in Section 3.

5. Draw Winner

- (a) The draw for the Eligible Match will take place during half time of the Eligible Match at AAMI Park on Sunday 6 November at approx 5.30 PM AEST.
- (b) Winners must be physically attending the match to be in the running and be in the stadium stands at halftime during the promotion when the winners are announced by the Match Ground Announcer. Any costs associated with attending the Eligible Match including costs for travel to and from the Eligible Match will be the responsibility of the Participant.

Publication of Winner

Draw Winners will be published on Western United's Facebook page on Monday 7 November.

6. Proxy or replacement participant

Under no circumstances whatsoever will a proxy or replacement for the Participant be permitted to take part in the Game if the Draw Winner is unable to participate for any reason. An ID check will be carried out by the Promoter's promotional staff prior to the Game starting to ensure the drawn winner is the correct Participant.

7. The Selection

- (a) To be available for selection the entrant must have completed the entry form as mentioned in section 4 above.
- (b) During the match Western United staff will download the data from the entry form.
- (c) They will then use a random selection program to download the data and randomly select two entrants as the winners of the two available prizes. This will be witnessed and filmed for records.
- (d) Western United staff will select 4 back up winners if the initial two are not at the eligible match.
- (e) At half time the ground announcer will announce the randomly selected winners (two winners). If the winners cannot be identified to be at the eligible match, the back-up winners will be contacted ASAP.

8. The Prizes
